Mentor UMC Scholarship for Post Secondary Education

Deadline: April 6, 2018 4PM

The Scholarship Committee is pleased to offer Mentor UMC scholarships for both vocational and academic post secondary pursuits.

THIS YEAR: Scholarships will be awarded not only to high school graduating seniors in 2018, current undergraduate college students, and seminary students, but also to current vocational school students.

Students who are in the present senior high school class, vocational school students, college students, and seminary students are eligible to apply. As in past years, the student applying must be a member of Mentor United Methodist Church (as of April 1, 2017) and meet all other eligibility requirements. If you were confirmed, you are a member. This application is designed to be completed online and then printed. You are to mail or deliver this along with your essay and other required documents to the scholarship committee.

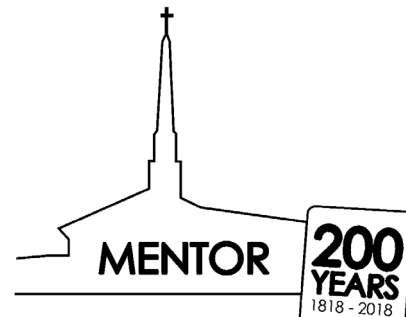
