DO YOU HAVE A HEART TO HELP HURTING KIDS?

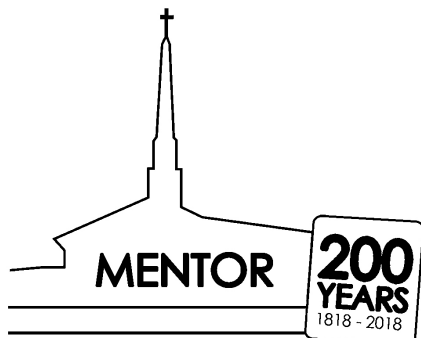
