We started sponsoring Daniel M. Jarto Jaymen in 2011 as a middle school student and he just now finished his second semester of college. He is now an adult in his late twenties. His education has been disrupted many times (civil war, Ebola crisis, financial issues) yet he keeps persevering.

The Liberia conference recently set a 3.0 GPA requirement for all scholarship students to keep receiving support. He is so proud to report a GPA of 3.39! He is studying Public Administration as his major and Sociology as a minor.
