General Conference: Post Conference Information Meeting at MUMC

On Monday, March 11 at 7:00 PM, the pastors will be offering a follow-up information meeting from the special called General Conference. The special conference was held on February 23 – 26 with the express purpose of dealing with issues around human sexuality. The conference voted to keep the present language prohibiting the ordination of practicing homosexuals and the performance of same-sex marriages in our churches and by our pastors. The adopted plan adds to the enforcement of these prohibitions. The plan continues to affirm that all persons from the LGBTQ+ community are persons of sacred worth and that we are to be engaged in ministry to and with them. We will address how the conference and actions taken will impact the denomination, our local church, and our ministry to the LGBTQ+ community.
