General Conference: Post Conference Information Meeting at MUMC

On Monday, March 11 at 7:00 PM, the pastors will be offering a follow-up information meeting from the special called General Conference. The meeting will be held in the Chapel and no RSVP is necessary. The special conference was held on February 23 – 26 with the express purpose of dealing with issues around human sexuality. The conference voted to keep the present language prohibiting the ordination of practicing homosexuals and the performance of same-sex marriages in our churches and by our pastors. The adopted plan adds to the enforcement of these prohibitions. The plan continues to affirm that all persons from the LGBTQ+ community are persons of sacred worth and that we are to be engaged in ministry to and with them. We will address how the conference and actions taken will impact the denomination, our local church, and our ministry to the LGBTQ+ community.

Following the General Conference on February 23 – 26, there will be three informational post-conference meetings across our annual conference. Laity are encouraged to attend. The last meeting is Sunday, March 10, 4:00 – 5:50 at Strongsville UMC.

Special Charge Conference

There will be a special called Charge Conference on Thursday, March 14 at 6:00 PM at MUMC. The meeting will be held in the Chapel. The only agenda item is to consider the recommendation of Sean O'Neil to the District Committee of Ordained Ministry as a candidate for ministry. The Staff-Parish Relations Committee approved him to come before the Charge Conference. The Charge Conference vote will be to recommend him or not recommend him to the District Committee of Ordained Ministry.

Staff Position Posting - GEM Secretary/Treasurer

The Staff-Parish Relations Committee is seeking qualified candidates for the position of GEM Secretary/Treasurer. The primary responsibility is to facilitate the disbursement and reporting of all funds under the GEM (Gifts, Endowment, and Memorials) Committee. The GEM Secretary/Treasurer will work with coworkers, congregation members, other Mentor UMC leaders, and those in banking and investment firms. This position will work under the GEM Committee and the Senior Pastor. They must be able to organize and manage their own work schedule, and do so with little supervision. The position is part-time with flexible hours varying from 8 - 10 hours a week, but can be as low as 3 and as high as 18. Expanded hours and responsibility are a possibility. The slowest months are September, November and December; the busiest months are January, March and April. There are some evening meeting requirements.



Primary duties include:

1. Using GAAP, provide accurate monthly accounting of GEM funds
2. Provide an annual report to the congregation
3. Carry out all financial matters voted on by the GEM Committee
4. Handle disbursement requests
5. Provide GEM Committee meeting minutes

Requires 2-4 years in a financial management position, or 3-5 years in related work experience with proficiency in GAAP. Demonstrate a proficiency in financial and word processing and spreadsheet programs including MS Excel, MS Word, MS PowerPoint and Outlook. Candidate should have an understanding of Endowment accounting. Should be comfortable working with computer data software. Problem solving and analytic skills are a plus. This staff person must be able to exhibit courtesy, cooperation and confidentiality in all dealings with members of the congregation, staff and the general public.
