Being a missionary can be really fun. They get to try new foods, learn new languages, and even make some pretty neat looking crafts. Let yourself experience the cultures of the world and see if the missionary life appeals to you.

#### Togo Banana Salad

In Togo, West Africa, banana salad is a favorite among the children. For a taste of Togo, whip up this fruity treat. You'll need: 2 bananas (1/2 banana, cut lengthwise for each person), lettuce, mayonnaise, peanuts. Select a nice leaf of

lettuce and place it on a salad plate. Lay half the banana on the leaf of lettuce. Spread 1 teaspoon mayonnaise on top of banana. Add 1 teaspoon ground or chopped peanuts across top of mayonnaise. Enjoy!

#### Japanese Koi

In Japan kids love to make *koi. Koi* is a kite that looks like a fish. You can make one using colored tissue paper, crayons, string, and a paper sack.

Cut a large circle in the bottom of the sack for the fish's mouth. Draw large black circles on the sides of the sack for eyes. Use crayons or markers to decorate your fish. Glue strips of colored paper on the fish's tail. Punch two holes in the bottom of each sack (in the corners above the mouth) and tie a piece of string through the holes to make a handle. When you're finished flying your *Koi*, you can hang it in your room.
