

You need: 2 cups flour, 1 cup salt, and 3/4 c. water

Mix all your ingredients in a bowl. Roll the dough out flat on wax paper. Use some of your favorite Christmas cookie cutters to cut out the shape of your ornament. Next, punch a hole near the top with a straw. Bake 40-50 minutes at 350 degrees, or until the back starts turning brown. Let them cool. Now dig out some acrylic paint and candies, and bring that shape to life. (Example: Glue red hots on for holly or buttons, use mini M&M's for eyes, etc.) After it's dry, tie a ribbon or yarn through the hole. Finally, hang that sweet looking ornament on the tree!

Candy Cane Cans

You need:1 can with open top, glue, candy canes, rubber band, and ribbon

Here is how you can make a totally cool CCC (Candy Cane Can). Place your can on a table with the open end on top. Glue candy canes all the way around the can, with each candy cane touching so that you cannot see the can. Make sure the hooked end of the cane is at the bottom. Place a rubber band around the candy canes to hold them in place. Tie a ribbon around the rubber band and make a bow. Isn't that pretty? Now fill the can with anything you want (pencils, flowers, false teeth, more candy). If it will fit, you can stick it in the can. News Flash: This makes a great gift.
