The organizations we serve have strict guidelines for dress. LONG PANTS are required for some activities. Please pay close attention to the daily itinerary. These rules apply every day:

- 1. <u>ALL SHOES MUST BE CLOSED TOE</u>. Tennis shoes are preferred. **Absolutely NO flip-flops, sandals, bare feet**.
- 2. <u>MODEST DRESS IS REQUIRED</u>. T-shirts must have sleeves. Shorts must be mid-thigh length and longer than the tips of your fingers at regular arm length when standing. **Absolutely NO tank tops, crop tops, short shorts, or saggy pants**.

No apparel with inappropriate designs or writing. You will often be bending, stretching, lifting. Be sure all apparel and necklines keep you modestly covered for these activities.

Bring a packed lunch and drink every day except Friday.
