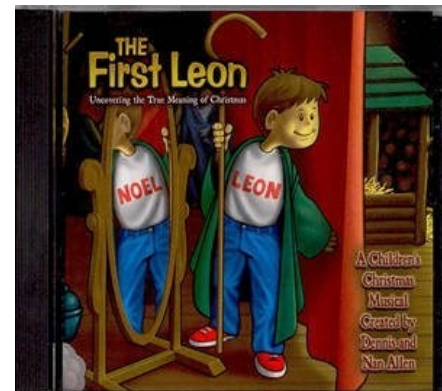

PAUL'S JOURNEY

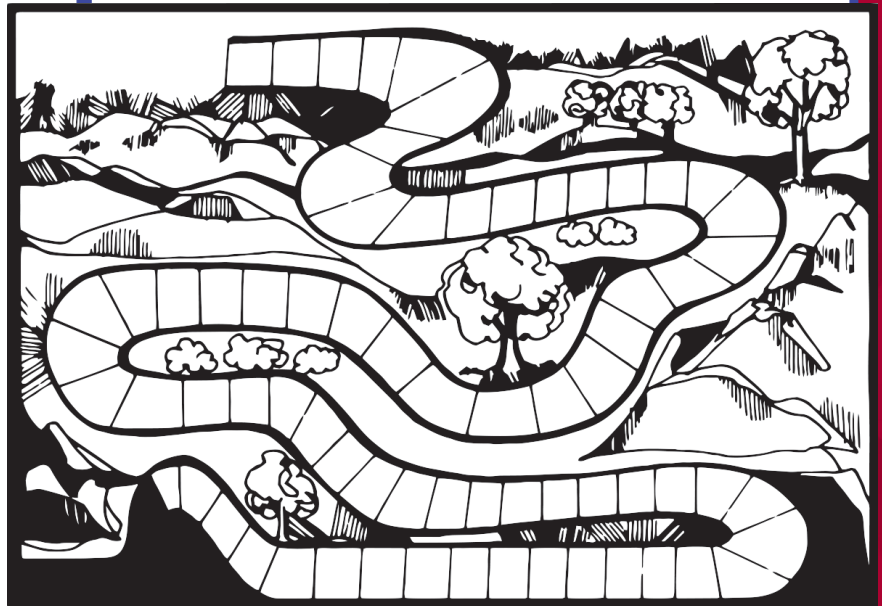
