A fantastic interactive way to reinforce the lesson of Trust and Faith is by leading this simple, inexpensive game. The Trust Walk Mine Field game is a game where everyone is a winner. Pair each child with one another and apply a blindfold to one of them. Use scarves, bandanas, or something similar around the house to make blindfolds. Once the children are ready, place items around the room at random. Identify these items as the "mines." The overall goal of the game is for the blindfolded children to be led through the minefield without touching any of the scattered mines. One rule is that the blindfolded child can't talk but listens to the verbal cues given by their partner. These cues should guide them through the obstacles. Swap partners after a designated time period so each child gets to have their turn. Then read Isaiah 42:16 and discuss what it is like to follow God and trust Him completely.



Stop Hunger Now ~ Saturday, May 17

On Saturday, May 17th 2014 Mentor United Methodist Church will be hosting a mobile packing event as part of Change the World 2014. The event requires 150 volunteers over two 2-hour shifts to pack 30,000 highly nutritious dehydrated meals which will include 21 essential vitamins and minerals. We are also raising \$8,000 for the meals themselves and their transportation to and from our church.

Packing will take place in two shifts from 9 to 11 AM and 1 to 3 PM. Sign up to volunteer on the 17th by clicking <u>here</u>. If you would like childcare for your 3 year old and younger, please contact Tammy no later than May 10.
