Thanks to the generosity of our congregation and your committed giving through multiple *In This House* Campaigns, the church recently was able to make our final payment on our mortgage with Erie Bank.


We were able to pay off a \$2,500,000 mortgage in just seven and a half years.

Paying off this Erie Bank Mortgage was a major milestone for Mentor United Methodist and is worthy of a celebration, but it is important to note that the church also received a \$610,000 loan for the *In This House* construction project from our own gifts, endowments, and memorials (GEM) fund. We have been paying interest on that loan throughout the life of the Erie Bank Mortgage, and now with the mortgage retired, we will be able to use future pledges and contributions to pay down the principal on the outstanding loan from GEM.



We appreciate your continued support. If you will contribute towards this debt you can note "retire GEM Loan" on your envelope or check or select "ITH III" as the fund type if submitting an online payment through the MUMC website.
