#### The Order for Confirmation & Reception into the Church

Those to be confirmed shall stand before the minister, who, addressing the people shall say,

Dearly beloved, the Church is of God, and will be preserved to the end of time, for the conduct of worship and the offering of his Word and Sacraments. It maintains Christian fellowship and discipline, provides for the edification of believers, and works towards the conversion of the world. All, of every age and station, stand in need of the means of grace which the church alone supplies.

#### The Sacrament of Holy Baptism Leia Marie Toivonen

These persons who are to be confirmed have received the Sacrament of Baptism, have been instructed in the teachings of the Church, and are now ready to profess publicly the faith into which they were baptized.

Then the minister, addressing those who are to be confirmed, shall say,

Do you here, in the presence of God, and of this congregation, renew the solemn promise and vow that you made, or that was made in your name, at your Baptism? *I do.* 

Do you confess Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior and pledge your allegiance to his kingdom?

I do.

Do you receive and profess the Christian faith as contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments? *I do.*  Do you promise according to the grace given you to live a Christian life and always remain a faithful member of Christ's holy church? *I do.* 

Will you be loyal to the United Methodist Church, and uphold it by your prayers, your presence, your gifts, your service and your witness? *I will.*
