Hodges arrangement in 1864 used words from Robert Seagrave and Charles Wesley. The words we sing today we written by Henry Van Dyke in 1907 for a Methodist hymnal. Edward Hodges was born in Bristol, England in 1796. He was an accomplished organist, who in addition to playing, made several technical advancements to the instrument. He earned a Doctorate of Music from Cambridge University. In 1839 he moved to New York City and served two churches. One was St. Johns Chapel and the other was Trinity Church, located near Wall Street. Suffering from poor health, he returned to England i 1863. He died in Bristol in 1867






