Hymn History: The music to this hymn was written by George Elvey. He was born in Canterbury. England in 1816. Elvey came from a musical family and as a boy, sang in the choir at Canterbury Cathedral. He was an accomplished organist and before he reached the age of seventeen, he was appointed to serve as an organist at Oxford University. He was appointed as organist at St. George's Chapel, Windsor in 1835. This chapel is on the grounds of Windsor Castle and is where Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Philip are buried. Elvey wrote music for special occasions for Briton's royals. He was knighted in 1871 and remained at St. George's until he retired in 1882. He wrote many hymns that are performed today, several are in our hymnal. He died in Windlesham, England in 1893.
