
Hymn History: The words to this hymn were written by Earl Marlatt. He was born in Columbus, Indiana in 1892. His father was a Methodist minister. Marlatt graduated from DePauw University and later from the Boston University School of Theology. He taught at BU for over twenty years. This hymn was written to mark the consecration of the school of religious education at the university. Marlatt later taught at the Perkins School of Theology at Southern Methodist University. This hymn was set to the music of the hymn BEACON HILL by Harry Mason. The words to this hymn are in reference to Mark 10:35–40 where Jesus asks James and John if they understand the sacrifices the must make to follow Him and that He cannot give them places to HIs right and left in glory. Professor Marlatt died in 1976.




