Hoffman added the words to complete the hymn in 1887 Elisha Hoff was born in Órwigsburg, Pennsylvania in 1839. He learned music from his father, an Evangelical minister. He was ordained a Presbyterian minister in 1873 after attending Union Seminary (now Albright College). Hoffman moved to Cleveland where he worked in the publishing division of the Evangelical Association for 11 years. He then pastored churches in Cleveland and Grafton, before moving to Benton Harbor, Michigan and then to Cabery, Illinois. Hoffman wrote over 2,000 hymns He died in Chicago in 1929.






