"Guide Me, O Thou Great Jehovah" *OPENING HYMN Hymn History: The words to this hymn were written by William Williams. His full name was William Williams Pantycelyn, having added the last name from the farm where he lived. He was raised in a Non- Conformist family, meaning they did not belong to the Anglican Church. In spite of this fact, Williams felt the call to the clergy and join the Anglican Church and was made a Deacon. He soon became involved in the new Methodist movement. As a result, he was denied entering the priesthood of the Anglicans. He traveled throughout Wales preaching the ideas of the Welsh Methodists, a parallel but separate movement from the English Methodists of John Wesley. He supported himself by selling tea. Williams wrote hymns in both English and Welsh. The hymn we sing today was originally written in Welsh and was translated into English by Peter Williams (no relation). It was set to the tune Cwm Rhondda written by John Hughes. This music is also used for God of Grace and God of Glory (Hymn 577). William Williams Pantycelyn died in 1791 at the Pantycelyn farmhouse.


