Hymn History: The music to this hymn was written by Norman Warren. He was born in London, England in 1934. Educated at Cambridge University, he excelled at both cricket and music. He was ordained an Anglican Priest in 1960. Warren served several churches in England. He eventually became Archdeacon and Canon of the Diocese of Rochester, England. He wrote a booklet titled Journey Into Life which describes who Jesus was and led many into accepting Him. It sold over 30 millions copies and was published in over 100 languages. He also wrote over 100 hymns. He frequently teamed up with Michael Perry on hymns like the one we sing today. He and his wife, Yvonne, had five children and eleven grandchildren. Norman Warren died in 2019.


