\*OPENING HYMN "Come Ye Sinners, Poor and Needy" UMH 340 Hymn History: The words to this hymn were written by Joseph Hart. He was born in London, England in 1712. He was raised in a Christian family. Well educated, he taught classical languages. Hart struggled with his relationship with God and fell into the conviction that as long as he believed, he could live a debauched life. He disputed John Wesley's view on doing good works. In 1757, Hart had a vision of the agony of Christ in the Garden of Gethsemane and understood that Christ died for him. Realizing the error of his ways, he apologized to Wesley. His change in behavior was completed under the ministry of George Whitefield, a leader in the Methodist movement. Hart became a minister and wrote a volume of hymns. He is considered one of the most spiritual of the 18th century English hymn writers. Joseph Hart died in London in 1768.
