Hymn History: The words and music to this hymn were written by Doris Akers, one of the most prolific gospel writers of the twentieth century. Akers was born in Brookfield, Missouri in 1923 to a white father and black mother. She moved to Los Angeles in 1945 to pursue a musical career. She developed and directed the first interracial gospel choir in Los Angeles' history. Her first song was published in 1947. She co-wrote with Mahalia Jackson the gospel song, "Lord, Don't Move That Mountain" which sold over a millions copies. Later, she moved to Columbus, OH, Cedar Rapids, IA and Minneapolis MN as performer and choir director at various churches. She was named in 1995 a National Treasure by the Smithsonian Institution. She was inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame in 2001 (along with Elvis Presley). She died in 1995 in Edina, MN.
