"There's a Wideness in God's Mercy" *HYMN OF CENTERING Hymn History: The music to this hymn was written by Lizzie Tourjee. She was born in Newport, Rhode Island in 1858. She was 17 and attending Wellesley College when she wrote it. Her father, Eben Tourjee, who was the founder of the New England Conservatory of Music, suggested that she name the tune for the college she attended. Lizzie put the words to a poem, There's a Wideness to God's Mercy, that was written by Frederick Faber to give us the hymn we sing today. Faber was an English clergyman and poet. Eben Tournee put this hymn in the Methodist hymnal he was editing in 1878. The words express the magnitude of God's Mercy toward us and that His Grace is with us during our Christian journey. Lizzie Tourjee died in 1913 in Newton, Massachusetts.
