

Pastor's Letter

Hello Friends,

Here we are in the middle of February. As I reflect on the past few weeks of our sermon series, I can see the Holy Spirit at work with the timing of this series as we have been experiencing a variety of emotions since the beginning of this particular sermon series. I have appreciated the messages that have been given regarding how we can redefine our emotions through our faith. January 26, surprise was the emotion as Pastor Steve reflected on Paul and Silas's experience in jail and with the Roman guard. February 2, fear was the emotion, and Pastor Steve shared the story of being on the ladder when he was a youth. February 9, anger was the emotion, and Pastor Ivy reflected on Jesus being angry. This Sunday, Pastor Steve will be preaching on happiness.

My take away from the Healthy Congregations workshop is the Bowen family systems theory, the view that the family unit is an emotional unit where all the members are interconnected and influence each other. This is the basis for Healthy Congregations. In order for us to be calm in all types of situations, we need to be able to pause before we react in a fight or flight way. When we take a moment to consider what is happening in a given moment, we then can think about how we will react.

This all takes me back to the very beginning of creation. God created us to be in relationship with God and in relationship with one another. We are created to be in community and not to be in isolation. Living in community is not always easy. It becomes even more challenging when we are emotionally invested in the community. As we continue navigating our lives in days of chaos and uncertainty, my prayer for us all is to hold fast to our love for God and love for one another. I pray that we will be an example to others when we shine God's grace and love to everyone we encounter.

I look forward to worshiping with you this Sunday! To continue to be in community with you all, my faith family.


Blood Drive
