# Pastor's Letter




### Pastor's Discretionary Update

Friends, I love making sure that the MUMC Pastor's Discretionary Fund (PDF) supports folk in Lake County with emergency financial assistance. Through the PDF we are able to come alongside particular crisis situations and show the true heart of Mentor UMC.

I am so gratified by this church for its many charitable efforts. Through the PDF we are able to respond on the spot to temporary shelter/lodging, food shortages, utility bills, transportation issues and more. And at the onset, if you have ever contributed to the PDF, please accept this as a personal THANK YOU from the Pastors, me in particular. I take pride in the confidence in my 'discretion' toward financially helping others.

Generally, the office administrator is the first line of contact when requests come to the church. Together, we vet and verify the requests. And know that monies are never given directly to individuals, rather we make contact with apartment landlords, car repair shops, the water company, hotel reservations clerks and such. The PDF allows the Pastors to make direct financial assistance happen as we/Pastors are solicited.

Just to share, some requests happen when:



- a person was sick with Norovirus and unable to work, (no hours worked, no pay)....needing help paying a water and electric bill. a person working at a new job waiting for their first pay and needing rent monies while going to work.
- while escaping domestic violence, a mother and six-month-old child needed a hotel stay during snow storm.
  a person needing help with a portion of car repair costs.
  a disabled person needed a hotel stay while awaiting a delay in construction repairs to a new apartment.
  a parent with two children, ages 3 and 1, needing lodging after being hired for a new job.
  and many more.

In the 1990s, I became enthralled with the great gospel singer/ song-writer Mahalia Jackson. Well, she broke records with a song entitled "If I Can Help Somebody'. The lyrics say: If I can help somebody, as I travel along If I can help somebody, with a word or song. If I can help somebody, from doing wrong. Then, my living shall not be in vain.

We should feel so good to know that 'we have helped somebody, yes, many 'somebodies' in Lake County through our PDF. We have given a helping hand, a bit of support, a tidbit of good for 'somebody' and we are the better for it. God bless,  $-Pastor\ Ivy$
