WE LIVE IN COVENANT TOGETHER ACTS 2:1-18







In Acts 2:1-18 the writer Luke tells us about:

- the first time many different people worshipped together
- how the Holy Spirit was seen and felt by many,
- that 3,000 folk confessed a belief in Jesus Christ. This action is called 'Pentecost' and it represents the beginning, origins, the birthday of the Christian church. The story focuses on CHANGE.

As those who gathered listened to and understood one another, even through the various language barriers, a communal worship, never witnessed before, was formed. The Holy Spirit, often so difficult to describe, had an effect that made a CHANGE in the way worship is experienced forevermore. Its power was seen and felt by all around. And that same Holy Spirit from ole, is able to still be felt and seen in our present day lives. When the Holy Spirit is felt, we experience CHANGE.

Each Pentecost, I am always ready to belt out the great tune "Everything Must Change" made famous by the great jazz guitarist George Benson. I love Bernard Ighner's timeless classic:

Everything must change, Nothing stays the same,

The young become the old, Mysteries do unfold 'Cause that's the way of time,

Nothing and no one goes unchanged.

These verses show us that we do not have to remain changed and stay in our present comfort zone. God, through

And I suggest that if you want to grow and improve, move out of your comfort zone, be willing to CHANGE! You will never be able to get the fullness of what God has for you without CHANGE! Know that it would be a terrible thing to get to heaven and be shown a giant room with a locked door in it. And you ask: "God, what's behind that door?" And God says 'that's all the blessings you could have had but you wanted your comfort, not CHANGE. Trust God and know that God has bountiful blessings in store for us and CHANGE IS POSSIBLE.
