Pastor's Letter A New Creation



So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation...

- 2 Corinthians 5:17

Have you ever seen an eagle soaring high in the sky? Wings spread, they sail on the wind, elevated by invisible currents, evidence of a powerful force all around, felt but not seen. It's beautiful.

Our final book in our Children's Books series is *Fly, Eagle, Fly.* It is an old African tale retold by Chistopher Gregorowski. It is a story about an eagle chick that was rescued from a cliff just a couple days after it was born. The farmer who rescued the eagle took it home and raised it among his chickens. He seemed to think that if he raised it as a chicken among other chickens feeding it chicken food, it would pretty much be a chicken. The farmer's friend, however, sees that it is not a chicken, it is an eagle. "An eagle," he says, "does not belong to the earth, but to the sky." He coaxes the eagle, "Fly, eagle, fly!" It is to no avail. The eagle doesn't know it is anything other than a chicken, unable to fly high in the sky, convinced that it is bound to the earth like all the other chickens. Eventually, the farmer's friend wakes the farmer up before dawn and together they climb the mountain, carrying the eagle until they get to the cliff overlooking the valley far below. As they watch the sun rise, the eagle spreads its wings and together they wait in silence. Before long, they feel a gentle breeze and watch it lift the eagle into the sky, rising up with the sun.



Since the first century, Christians have tried to share what it is like when they found and accepted Christ in their lives. In Paul's second letter to the church in Corinth, he describes life with Christ as a new creation. "Everything old has passed away, everything has become new". Have you experienced that? Do you want to experience that or experience it anew? What old grudges, old habits, old addictions, old hates, old sorrows and grief would you like to have go away? What would the new you look like if you no longer had these heavy burdens weighing you down?

The writer, composer and musician Michael Joncas compared this new creation in Christ to being raised up on eagle's wings. In his hymn "On Eagle's Wings" (UMH 143), we sing,

"And God will raise you up on eagle's wings, bear you on the breath of dawn, make you to shine like the sun, and hold you in the palm of God's hand."

How do you describe the difference Christ has made in your life? I'd love to hear about it. I pray that in our worship and in our ministry together, we experience anew or for the first time the beautiful power, comfort and strength of Christ that raises us up and makes us new.




PMO dates are now up on the website. Join us in the preschool on Mondays starting September 9, 16, 23, 30.
